

**Call for volunteers
for the 3rd European event of the Europe Goes Local project**

JINT vzw, the Flemish knowledge centre for international youth mobility and youth policy is **looking for volunteers to support the implementation of the 3rd European event of the Europe Goes Local project.**

The project

The EGL project is a long-term strategic partnership between the National Agencies (NAs) of the Erasmus+ Youth in action programme and their partners. The core aim of the project is to raise the quality of local youth work in particular through enhanced cooperation between various stakeholders that are active at the municipal level. The partnership currently involves about 200 members who represent around 120 municipalities in the 22 participating European countries.

Parameters of the Conference

Date: 4 – 6 June 2018
Venue: Brussels, Belgium
Number of participants: ~200 pax

Aims and objectives of the event

- The conference will focus on the future European Charter on Local Youth Work and how to link the principles and topics of this charter to practical processes.
- Peer-learning with a European and international dimension to raise the quality of local youth work.

Target group

The audience will be composed of European and national level delegates who are active in the youth field and have a connection with youth work at the municipal level.

Description of the event

- Keynote speeches and roundtable discussions during plenary sessions
- Workshops
- Informal networking evenings
